8	PAYMENT TERMS	Review the payment terms and schedule. Know how much is required upfront, the payment milestones throughout the project, and the final payment. This helps manage cash flow and ensures you're not paying too much in advance.
9	COMPLIANCE AND INSURANCE	Ensure each company complies with local regulations and holds the necessary licenses and insurance. This safeguards you from liability and ensures the work meets Australian standards and legal requirements.
10	COMMUNICATION AND CUSTOMER SERVICE	Evaluate the responsiveness and professionalism of the company during the quoting process. Strong communication and customer service are good indicators of how they will manage the project and address any issues that come up.
